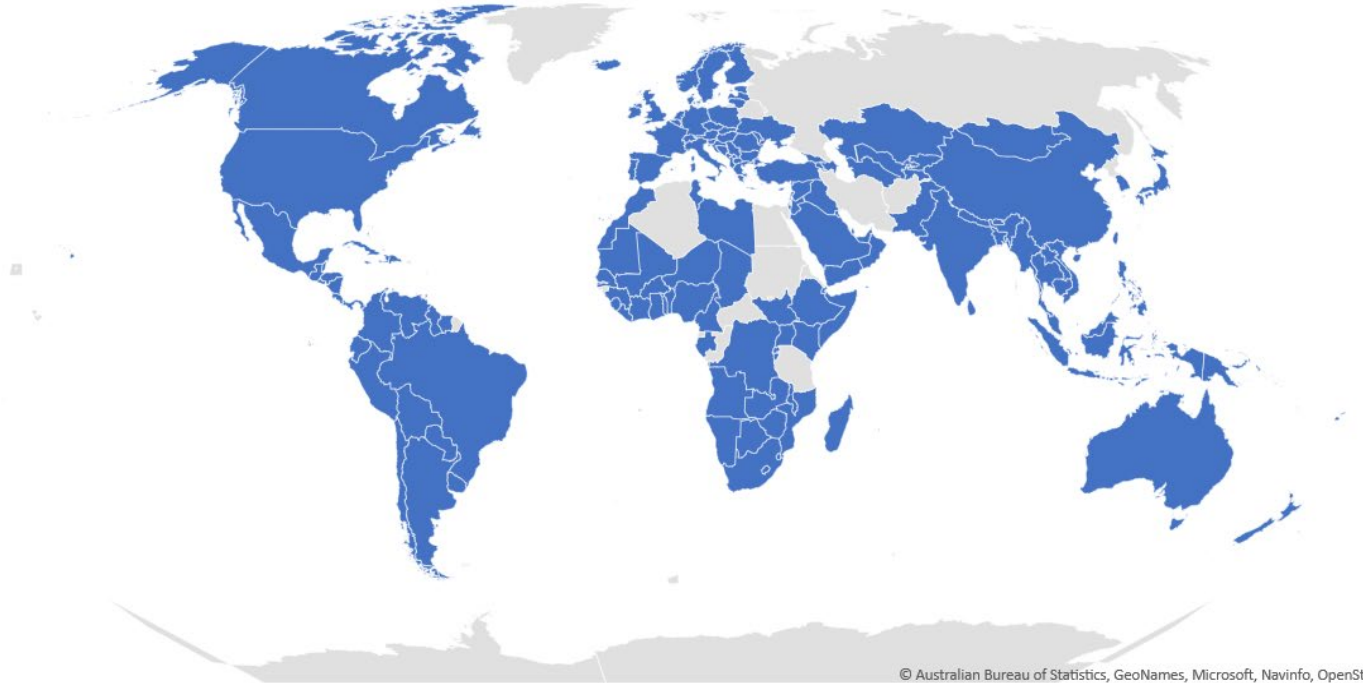
Digital SAT Updates

SAT Available in More than 180 Countries/Regions Worldwide

The digital SAT has been piloted and delivered to students around the world.

- 90% of students and educators said they **preferred** the digital SAT over paper and pencil
- 98% of students felt the Bluebook testing app was **easy to use**.
- 95% of student indicated they felt **comfortable** testing on their digital device

Like the SAT, the digital PSAT-related exams will be substantially shorter, lasting two hours and 14 minutes instead of three hours, with more time per question.

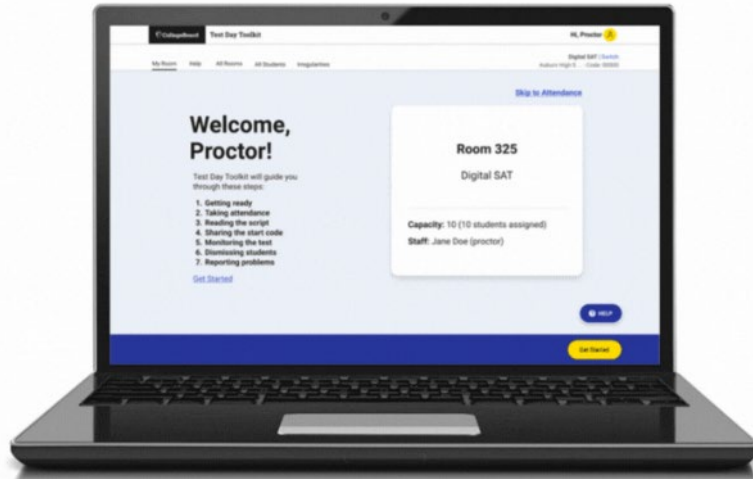

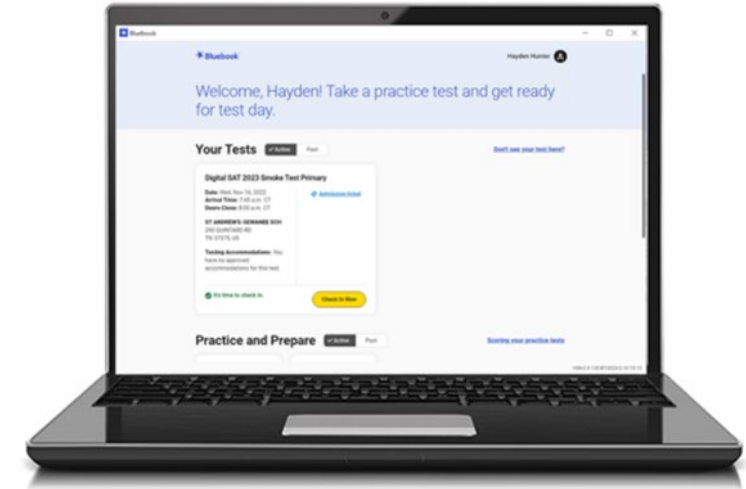
PSAT & SAT Use the Same Technology

Test Day Toolkit and Bluebook™ work together to make digital testing possible.

Test Day Toolkit (Educator)



Bluebook (Students)



Features:

- Guided experience for room setup and a short proctor script
- The code students need to start the test
- Dashboard for monitoring student testing
- Can be used on any device that can connect to the internet

Testing can be completed using the following devices:

- Windows laptops, tablets or desktops
- Mac laptops
- iPads
- School-managed Chromebooks

Key Administration Steps for Digital PSAT/NMSQT & PSAT 8/9

Ordering and Registration



- Submit accommodations requests**
• At least 7 weeks before testing
- Gain access to SAT Suite Ordering and Registration (SSOR)**
- Order exams**
• 5 weeks before test date
- Submit Initial Registration File**
• At least 3-4 weeks prior to testing
- Data validation and registration**
• At least 2-3 weeks prior to testing

Near Test Day



- Digital readiness check**
• At least 1-2 weeks prior to each test date

Score Release



- Share Scores with students**
- Encourage to create College Board accounts**

SSOR - Ordering

- Currently open for digital PSAT/NMSQT and PSAT 8/9.
- Schools will be provided with an estimated cost when they place an order.
- Schools will be invoiced on students who are registered to test.
- During ordering, the following information will be required:
 - Key Staff that will be responsible for test administration
 - Which assessment(s) you plan to administer to which grade level(s)
 - The number of students you plan to test
 - Intended Start Date/Week for Testing

Access to SAT Suite Ordering and Registration (SSOR)

Roles must be assigned to access the system.

- **Important!** These roles must be assigned to complete required actions ahead of test day
- If one person will be managing multiple roles, they should be assigned each role they need.

SAT Suite Ordering/Registration Access Manager

Uses the Managing Access Tool to assign ordering and registration roles to colleagues—and themselves—so they can order tests and/or register test takers using SAT Suite Ordering and Registration

SAT Suite Ordering

Places and manages test orders for the SAT Suite of Assessments using SAT Suite Ordering and Registration

SAT Suite Data Coordinator

Uploads test taker data for test registration

SAT Suite Registration

Manages test registrations in an online registration roster. They can view the test taker data uploaded by data coordinators and validate the data for accuracy, including the ability to make updates



SSOR - Registration

- Registration is **required** for all students to test.
- Registration opened on Sept. 5.
- Registration is a 2-step process:
 - Step 1: Registration file upload
 - Step 2: Validation and registration
- Registration file specifications are posted on the SAT Suite Educator Experience website - <https://satsuite.collegeboard.org/k12-educators/educator-experience>
- The test coordinator and SSD coordinator need to review the registration data and accommodations for each student.

Digital Readiness Check

Purpose of the digital readiness check:

- Ensure devices being used for testing meet technical requirements
- Ensure Bluebook is installed correctly
- Complete Exam Set-Up process
 - ✓ Review of test taker rules
 - ✓ Includes providing optional test taker information
- Complete Test Preview
 - ✓ Explore universal tools
 - ✓ Answer sample questions

Requesting Accommodations

- **Deadlines have passed for October for PSAT/NMSQT**, extended for PSAT 8/9.
- **NEW!** For October 2023 administrations, accommodations for PSAT 8/9 must be requested and approved by College Board's SSD Online system.
- For students who've already been approved by SSD for accommodations there's no need to re-request accommodations.

- Test Preview
 - Short set of real test questions
 - Try out testing tools
 - Practice with assistive technology
- Full-Length Practice
 - Scored tests
 - Timed just like real tests, except students can pause at any time
 - Access My Practice at <https://mypractice.collegeboard.org/dashboard> to view scores

Khan Academy®

- Digital SAT Course
- Includes videos, articles, and worked examples

As part of the digital readiness check, have your students complete either a test preview or a full-length practice test.

Educator Reports

Enhancements to educator reports include:

- Aggregate Score Reports versus Student-Level Score Reports
- Run aggregate performance reports by administration and season
- Selection of an individual grade, ALL grades (NEW), or most common grade combination
- Ability to customize the fields displayed in a Roster report
- New Knowledge and Skills Report to inform curriculum and instruction.
- Revised Skills Insight tool which includes exemplar items

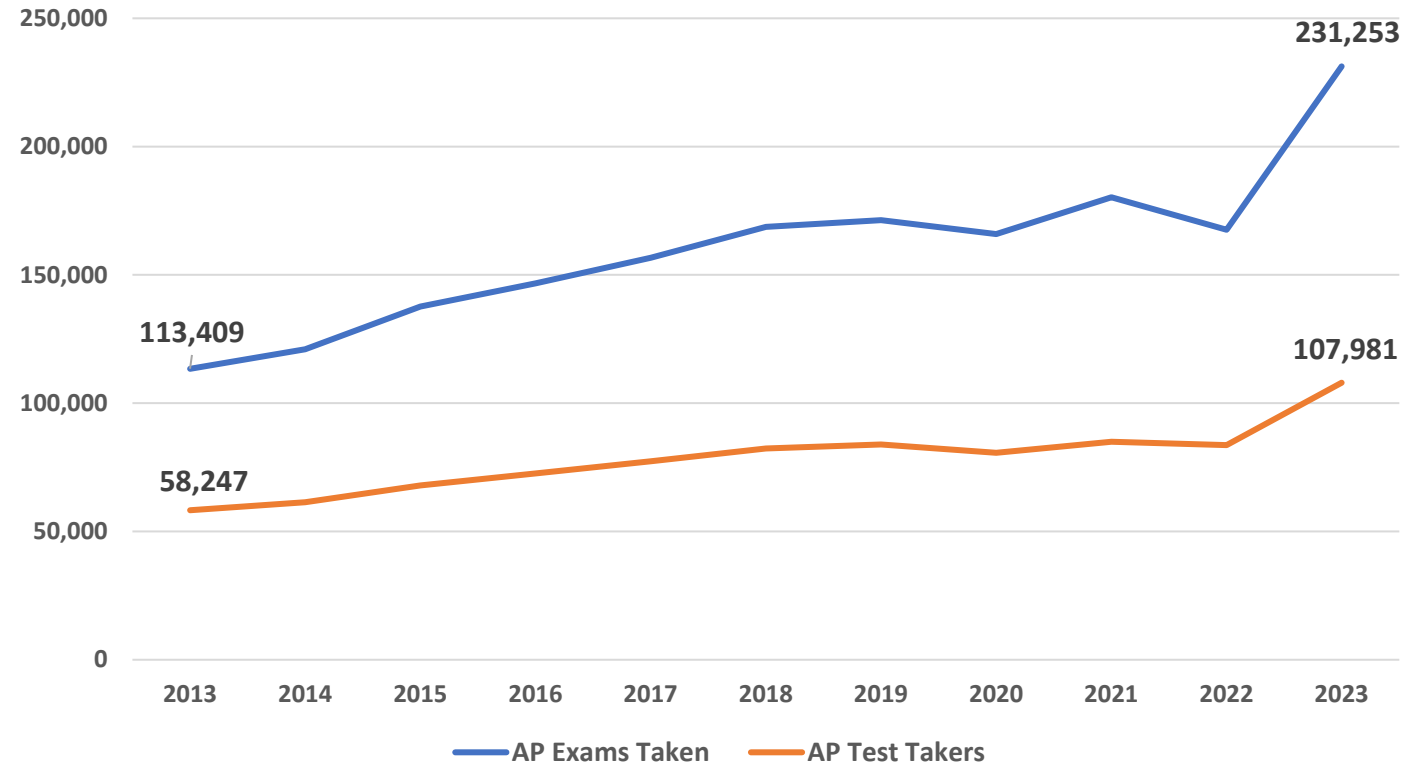

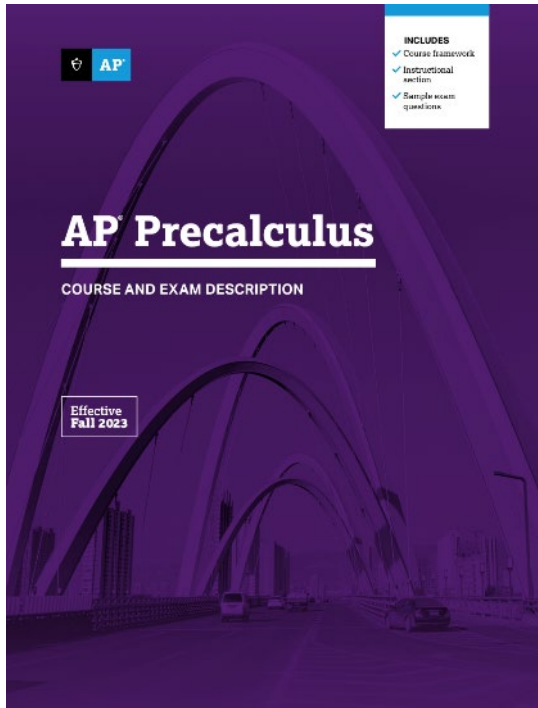
International AP Program Usage Nearly Doubles in Last Ten Years

AP Exams Taken & Exam Takers Outside of the U.S. by Year



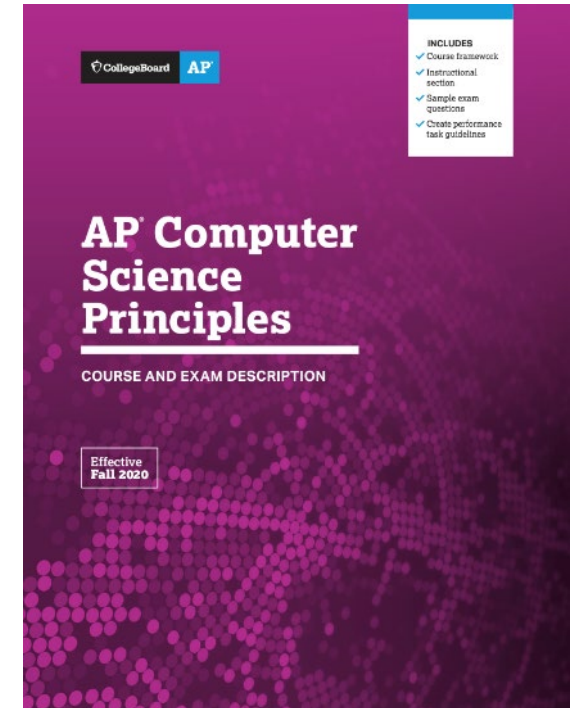
